


27 responses over the 3 week survey period


How often do you use the space?



What do you use the Reflection Room for?




On average, how long do you use the space at a time?



Reflection Room Subcommittee

During November of 2022, a survey was conducted of the users of the Reflection Room. The Facilities Advisory Board subcommittee came together and analyzed the survey results. Those results were compiled into a list of modifications and additions.

The Facilities Advisory Board subcommittee recommends to Union Council the Reflection Room change or add the following items:

Immediate Term (During Winter break/early Spring 2023):

- 1. Add an arrow to the floor indicating the direction of the Qibla
- 2. Implement more frequent cleaning and vacuuming plan
- 3. Remove large round chairs
- 4. Replace worn area rug with a new rug

Mid-term (Summer 2023)

- 5. Remove the rules on the outside of the space and replace with a more inviting sign, designed by Union Marketing. Place the rules on the interior of the room as to remain visible
- 6. Label shoe rack as use for shoes only
- 7. Add a credenza for storage of personal items
- 8. Add artificial plants and greenery to the space
- 9. Add movable partitions to the space
- 10. Replace white lights with warmer color
- 11. Have Union Marketing run a campaign to promote the updated space

Long-term

12. Implement a preparation station near the room. Possible location is 3rd floor pantry (351) across from the Northwoods room.

Privacy:

- 13. Add a scheduling system to allow the space to be reserved (15 minutes)
- 14. Restrict usage to just prayer during designated times
